#### ENGLISH MEDIUM SECONDARY SCHOOL PROVISION

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with Section 42 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code, that Cardiff Council (herein after “the Authority”), having consulted such persons as appeared to them to be appropriate, propose to:

- Increase the capacity of Cantonian High School, Fairwater Road, Fairwater, Cardiff, CF5 3JR from 6 forms of entry (180 places per year group) to eight forms of entry (240 places per year group), with sixth form provision for up to 250 pupils, by replacing the current school buildings with larger, new build accommodation on the same site; and
- Expand the Specialist Resource Base (SRB) at Cantonian High School for learners with an Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC) from 20 to 30 places in the enlarged purpose built accommodation in the new school buildings.

It is proposed to implement the proposal from September 2023.

The school is currently maintained by Cardiff Council.

The Authority undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. A consultation report containing a summary of the issues raised by consultees and the Authority’s responses and the views of Estyn is available to view at:

The current school capacity is 1,046 including sixth form. The current number of pupils at the school is 573 (11-16) and 52 (sixth form).

The number of pupils to be admitted to the school in Year 7 (the relevant age group), at age 11, in the first school year in which the proposal is to be implemented will be 240.

The school’s proposed capacity once the proposal is implemented will be 1,450 places including sixth form.

Admissions to the school are managed by the local authority.

The SRB is currently resourced for 20 pupils aged 11 – 19 with statements of special educational need specific to autism spectrum conditions.

Admissions to the SRB are managed by the local authority. Placements would be subject to a statement of Special Education Need in accordance with the Special Education Code of Practice for Wales 2002 and the new Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal (Wales) Act 2018 (when in force).

There are no plans to change the Council's policy on the admission of children to schools as a result of these proposals.

Any arrangements for the transport of pupils will be made in accordance with the Authority's existing policies on school transport.

Within a period of 28 days of the date of publication of these proposals, that is to say by 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019, any person may object to these proposals.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This does not form part of the Notice but is intended to explain its general meanings)

It is proposed that the capacity of Cantonian High School is increased from 180 pupils per year group to 240 pupils per year group and that the existing SRB provision at the school be expanded from 20 to 30 places from September 2023.

It is proposed to replace the existing school with enlarged new build accommodation.

In addition to the proposed expansion and replacement of Cantonian High School and the SRB, it is also proposed to transfer Riverbank Special School and Woodlands High School to the Cantonian High School site and increase the capacity of both schools. Any new buildings required in the event of the proposal proceeding to implementation would be designed to meet Welsh Government Funding conditions such as BREEAM and also be designed in accordance with the Department of

Education Building Bulletins which sets out that the following facilities need to be included in any school:

- Teaching space: internal and external
- Halls
- Dining area
- Learning resource areas
- Staff and administration
- Storage
- Toilets and personal care
- Kitchen facilities
- Circulation
- Plant and internal walls
